


Bristol Cathedral Choir School
Sixth Form Dress Code



We are a highly desirable Sixth Form and believe that all students in the Sixth Form must **dress appropriately for an educational setting** in order to provide the wider community with a positive image of Bristol Cathedral Choir School and Sixth Form and prepare them for future employment.

As a member of our Sixth Form, we expect that you come to school **dressed smartly**. **Lanyards** and name badges must be **visible at all times**. Coats and hats must be removed in lessons. **Phones and headphones** are allowed in school, but **must not be visible** when students are walking around the site as lower school students are not permitted these items and the 6th form students should be modelling our high standards.

Items appropriate to wear are: 	You are not allowed to wear: 
<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Plain colour trainers (preferably black) or polishable shoes or boots- Shirts, blouses, polo shirts- Skirts or dresses (length towards the knee)- Smart trousers or chino-style shorts- Jumpers and cardigans- Suits and ties- Formal religious wear (e.g. an abaya or thawb)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Strappy or see-through tops- Hoodies- Jeans or cargo trousers- Clothing with prominent logos- Headphones around site- Athletic wear (except to Games)- Ugg style boots- Ripped clothing (including tights)
